JAVAD PARVIZI, MD

James Edward Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery Rothman Institute at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital, Philadelphia, PA

Dr. Parvizi is a board certified orthopaedic surgeon and has been at the Rothman Institute since 2003. He specializes in the management of young patients with hip disorders such as dysplasia and femoroacetabular impingement. He has performed over 1000 femoroacetabular osteoplasty procedures, 300 pelvic and femoral osteotomies, and over 5000 hip replacements in young adults and continues to lead the clinical research team at the Rothman Orthopaedic Institute.

Dr. Parvizi is a native of Azerbaijan, Iran and lived there until the age of 16. He completed his medical school education in the United Kingdom. Following graduation from medical school he spent four years in surgical training that included cardiothoracic surgery. Dr. Parvizi then traveled to the United States to spend two years at the Mayo Clinic to conduct research in identifying methods to regenerate cartilage and bone. After obtaining a Masters degree in molecular biology from the Mayo Clinic, Dr. Parvizi was offered a residency in orthopedic surgery at the Mayo Clinic. He completed his residency in orthopedic surgery at the Mayo Clinic and traveled to Switzerland to do a fellowship in the management of hip disorders in young adults. He spent time with Professor Ganz at the Inselspital, Berne in 2002. After completion of his fellowship, he joined the Rothman Orthopaedic Institute.

His personal area of interest in research and clinical practice includes prevention and diagnosis of joint infection, joint preservation in adults, and prevention of thromboembolism following orthopedic procedures. He has published over 700 scientific articles and has written 18 text books in related subjects including books on THE HIP and on THE KNEE. He has received numerous awards from societies and has received funding for his research from the National Institute of Health, Department of Defense, Orthopedic Research and Education Foundation, Musculoskeletal Transplant Foundation, Arthritis Foundation and numerous other funding bodies.

Dr. Parvizi travels extensively across the globe to give lectures related to his area of expertise and has been given the honorary membership of numerous societies around the world. He has served as the president of Musculoskeletal Infection Society (2013), Eastern Orthopedic Association (2018) and holds position the board of numerous organizations and societies.



ADOLPH LOMBARDI, MD
President, JIS Orthopedics
Clinical Assistant Professor, Department of Orthopaedics,
Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center, New Albany, OH

Dr. Adolph V. Lombardi, Jr., was born and educated in Philadelphia. He received his bachelor's degree from Saint Joseph's University, medical degree from Temple University, and residency training at Albert Einstein Medical Center. Dr. Lombardi pursued two fellowships in Adult Reconstruction of the Hip and Knee: one with Thomas H. Mallory, MD, at Joint Implant Surgeons in Columbus, and the other with Gerard A. Engh, MD, at the National Hospital for Orthopaedics and Rehabilitation and the Anderson Orthopaedic Institute in Arlington, Virginia. He joined the practice of Joint Implant Surgeons in 1987 and is now its president.

Dr. Lombardi's vision for a physician-owned musculoskeletal specialty hospital spurred the development of New Albany Surgical Hospital, which opened in December 2003 and became part of Mount Carmel Health System in January 2007. In 2013 he and his partners opened White Fence Surgical Suites and Southeastern Ohio Surgical Suites, where they have now performed over 10,000 outpatient arthroplasties. He is a Clinical Assistant Professor at The Ohio State University in the Department of Orthopaedics. Dr. Lombardi has been issued multiple patents in the field of Adult Reconstruction of the Hip and Knee which are related to both instrumentation and implants. He is a surgeon designer of the Maxim and Vanguard Knee Systems, the AVL Anti-Subluxation Rotating Hinge Knee, the Signature System of patient-specific guides, and the Taperloc Complete Hip System.

He is a reviewer several orthopaedic journals and has has been an oral examiner for the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery since 1997. Dr. Lombardi served as president of The Hip Society in 2011 and president of The Knee Society in 2017. In 2019 he was named Deputy Director of Current Concepts in Joint Replacement. He has been a volunteer surgeon for Operation Walk, traveling with the team to Nicaragua and Guatemala. In January 2011 he initiated Operation Joint Implant, a charitable program to provide quality orthopaedic care in Central Ohio, and later in his capacity as president of The Hip Society, expanded concept to a nationwide level as Operation Walk USA. He serves as president of its Executive Committee. In recognition of his humanitarian work, Dr. Lombardi was conferred an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree from Ohio Dominican University in 2011 and received the American Association of Hip and Knee Surgeons Humanitarian Award in 2015.

Joseph A. Bosco, III, MD is Vice Chairman for Clinical Affairs of the NYU Langone Department of Orthopedic Surgery, and Professor of Orthopedic Surgery at the NYU Grossman School of Medicine. Dr. Bosco has served as team physician for the Durham Bulls and Brooklyn Cyclones minor league baseball teams. From 2002 until 2004, he was a team physician for the New York Mets professional baseball team. He is a member of, and held leadership positions in, numerous professional societies, including The American Orthopedic Society for Sports Medicine (former member Board of Councilors), The American Orthopedic Association, The New York Academy of Medicine, The Eastern Orthopedic Association and the New York State Society of Orthopedic Surgeons (Vice President). He served as president of the BOD of The Orthopedic Learning Center.

He became a fellow of The American Academy of Orthopedic Surgery in 1992. His service to the AAOS began as a member of the Sports medicine evaluation committee after which he was chosen to complete the Leadership Fellows Program. Following service as chair of the Central Program Committee, he was appointed to the BOD. He then served as Chair of the Annual Meeting Committee until he was elected to the Presidential Line. He is currently the AAOS President in March as of 2020.

Dr. Bosco has published and lectured, both nationally and internationally, on Alternative Payment Models, healthcare policy and quality.

Dr. Kadakia is a professor of Orthopaedic Surgery within the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery. He serves as director of the Foot and Ankle Fellowship Program. During his career, he has authored more than 100 peer reviewed publications, reviews and book chapters and has lectured both nationally and internationally. Recently he has co-authored *Reconstructive Foot and Ankle Surgery - Management of Complications* with Dr. Myerson. He lectures both nationally and internationally as an invited speaker on Foot and Ankle. He has been active in the American Foot and Ankle Orthopedic Society (AOFAS) since 2007 and is actively involved with the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgery in their resident education. Among numerous honors, Dr. Kadakia received the James Stack Teaching Award, Orthopedic Surgery, in 2016; was noted among the Top 16 Orthopedic Foot and Ankle Surgeons in North America, Orthopedics This Week (2015); and received the William S. Smith Resident Teaching Award from the University of Michigan's Department of Orthopedic Surgery in 2011.
